


- Go to the home page of the MPS website at https://www.mps-pension.org.uk/
- Press the dark green 'Login or register' button in the top right corner
- If you're accessing the home page on mobile, press the three lines in the top right corner






- 1 Enter your personal details. Your email address will become your username when you log in in the future. A red error message will highlight where there are any issues with your details
- Your MPS membership number is MPS followed by an 8-digit number. You can find it on one of our recent letters but it's different to the payroll reference you'll find on your P60 or payslip (which start with either MP4 or MPQ). Alternatively, call us and we will give you your membership number please have your National Insurance number handy when you call.
- Confirm you've read the terms and conditions by ticking the box and then press 'Continue'

Portal v




- Press 'Get your verification code via email' It may take one or two minutes to arrive in your inbox. If it doesn't, first check your spam folder and then ask the portal to send it again
- Once you have the 10 digit verification code, enter it into the box and press 'Continue'. You can copy and paste directly from the email The code will expire in 10 minutes, so you'll need to request a new one if you don't enter it within that time




- Choose a security question, answer and a hint. You'll need this every time you log in Your question should be something that is easy for you to remember but is not known to anyone else and difficult to guess
- 2 Press 'Continue'

Step 5



- Set a secure password This must be 8 or more characters and made up of upper and lower case letters, numbers and special characters. It can't include any spaces
- Pressing the eye o icon will reveal the password to help you type, though you should only do this if you are not in a public space Press 'Continue'


You'll now be directed to the portal where you can log in using your details. There is further help on how to log in on the following pages



Step 3



- Enter your email address, which is the email address that you used when you registered (if you've forgotten your email press 'Forgotten your username')
- 2 Enter your password

Pressing the eye o icon will reveal the password to help you type, though only do this if you are not in a public space


3 Press 'Continue'

If you have forgotten your username go to page 10 and if you have forgotten your password go to page 12.

If you have incorrectly entered your details three times, your account will be temporarily locked.

You can unlock it yourself by retrieving your username or password.

Step 4




- Enter the answer to your security question. You will be asked to enter three random characters
 - If you have forgotten your answer, the hint that you set when you registered can be emailed to you by pressing the text 'Email yourself a hint'
- 2 Press 'Continue'

You'll now be logged in and see your personalised home page

Step 1




Your username is the email you used when you registered for the portal.

Enter your Surname, your Date of Birth, your MPS Membership Number, and your National Insurance Number



First press the 'Forgotten your password' text link below the password box on the log in screen. You'll need your username to reset your password. On the next screen do the following:


Enter your username, which is your email address

2 Press 'Continue'


Your username is your email address. If you have forgotten your username, press the text 'Forgotten your username' below the box and follow the steps on page 10
